*Please note: Depending on each years College timetable and VET course requirements, VET courses may be timetabled for an extended period either before the start of school (i.e. 7: 30 am) or after the completion of school (4:30 pm).

Selection Criteria

Selection for the Sport Academy (VCE VM) is based on the following

criteria:

- Evidence of academic ability to pursue undergraduate studies
- A desire to pursue a career in the sport industry
- Demonstrated ability in a Sport at an elite level
- Previous ACC (or similar School Competition) involvement and performance
- Involvement and performance in regular Physical Education classes
- General conduct and ability to demonstrate mutual respect to peers and staff
- Performance at Selection Trials
- Ability to uphold Parade College's Discipline and Uniform Policies
- Performance in local sporting competitions

Students whose application is short-listed will be required to attend an interview.

- 2x ½ days of curriculum content: Numeracy, Literacy, Personal Development and Work-Related Skills, and Tenete (RE).
- 2x 1/2 days of delivering skills and coaching sessions
- 1 full day of workplace learning or industry-focused projects and mentoring
- 1x 1/2 days of sport: skills, squad, strength, conditioning, delivering skills / coaching sessions.

After successful completion of the Sport Academy, students receive direct entry into courses at La Trobe University:

- Bachelor of Media and Communication
