This program is a part of the VCE Vocational Major (VM) and necessitates that students meet the minimum requirements for the VCE VM. Additionally, successful completion of a Certificate IV in Business is required to qualify for entry to La Trobe University. Students who enroll in the course should understand that it is a two-year program within the VCE VM. Further, excluding the General Achievement Test (GAT) in Yr 12, it does not involve externally scored assessments (i.e., examinations), and the subjects or course will not contribute to an ATAR score.

The program also incorporates structured workplace learning and enrollment in the relevant VET subjects. Acceptance into the Business Academy involves enrollment at the Preston Campus of Parade College. The College does not offer the option of transferring from the VCE VM to the VCE or between campuses once enrolled in the program.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Demonstrated a consistent record of upholding the college ethos, which includes showing respect and appropriate behaviour towards peers, teachers, and others.
- 2. A record of following college expectations. This not only includes adherence to the uniform policy and maintaining good attendance, but also timely submission of class work and assessment tasks.
- 3. A record of obtaining a 'C average' in the core subjects of English, Mathematics, and other elective subjects.
- 4. Articulated why they are interested in joining the Business Academy, what aspects of business studies they are most interested in, and how they believe the program will help them achieve their future career goals.
- 5. A basic understanding of the VCE VM program and be able to explain how they think it will contribute to their learning experience.
- 6. Ideally have some previous experience with structured workplace learning/work experience. If they do, they should be able to share their experiences and learnings and explain how they plan to apply the skills and knowledge gained in their studies and future career.
- 7. The ability to identify which courses at La Trobe University they are interested in and why.
- 8. Sought career advice before applying to this program.

Note:

- The program also incorporates structured workplace learning and enrolment in the relevant VET subjects.
- VET classes may be timetabled to commence before (i.e. 7:30 am) and/or conclude after regular school hours (i.e. 5:00 pm). Attendance during these times is required. Confirmation of times will be made available once timetables are released.
