This pathway offers practical learning experiences, including traineeships, industry-focused projects, and mentorship, ensuring students develop the skills and confidence needed to pursue vocationally oriented careers or further education. This contemporary approach equips students with a strong foundation in business, helping them succeed in a rapidly evolving job market.

The Certificate III in Community Services that students complete equips students with essential communication, teamwork, and problem-solving skills while providing insight into real-world social and community issues. 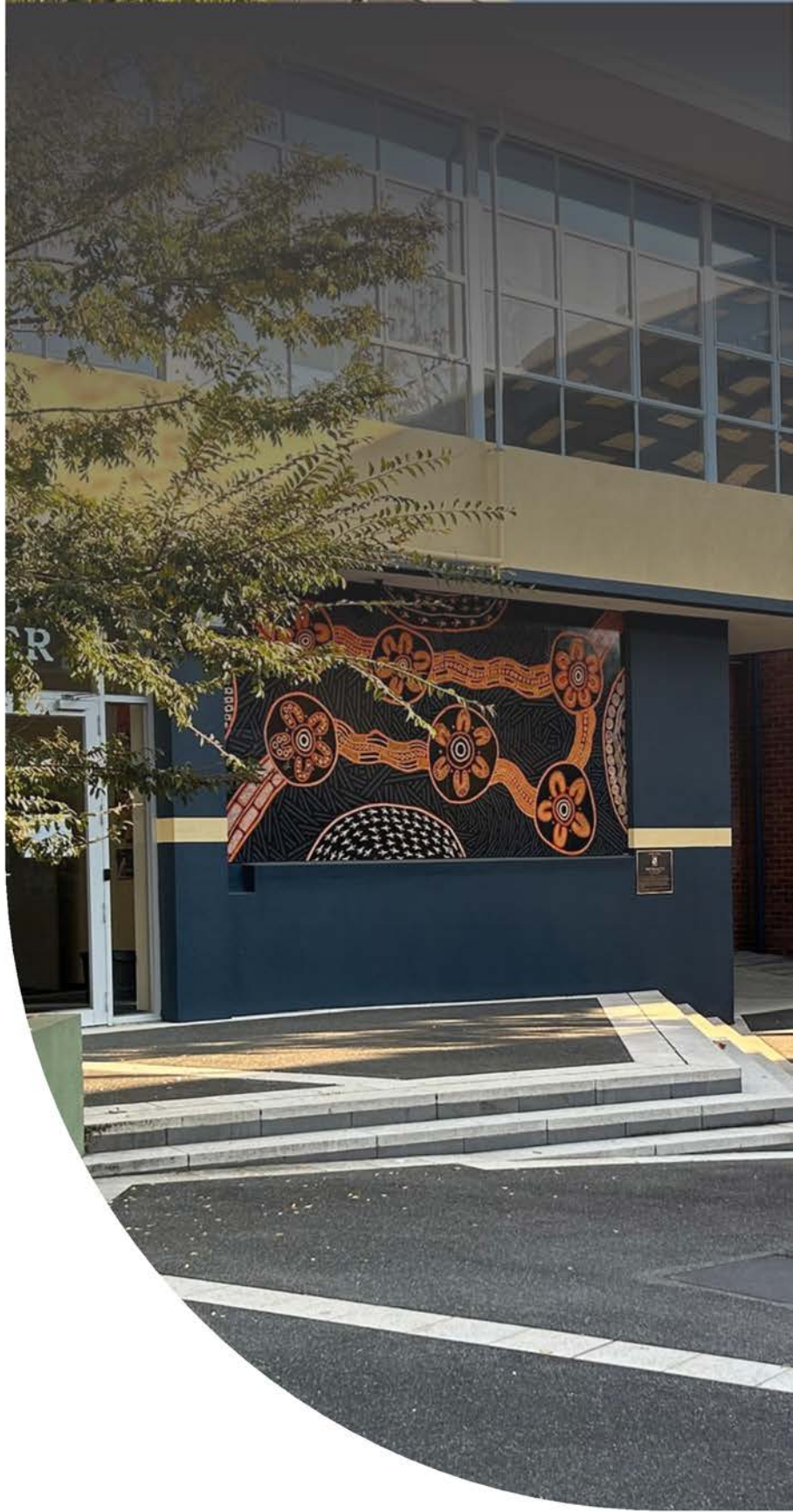
Beyond Year 12 at La Trobe University
