Step 2 – Selecting your subject preferences.

Students must select two semesters of Health and Physical Education and/or High-Performance Sport.



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- High Performance Sport should be selected in the semester of the ACC sport that you which to participate in.
- **Please Note:** There are <u>limited</u> places in High Performance Sport. Mr John Baxter (Dean of High Performance) will determine according to a set of criteria which students will be selected for High Performance Sport. All inquiries regarding this should be directed to Mr John Baxter.
- The next step here is choosing an 'Arts' elective and a 'Technology' elective subject.

- If you made any incorrect or invalid choices, a message in RED will show you why these choices were removed.
- It is best to then click on Cancel and fix the selection problems before proceeding.
- If everything looks okay, click on Submit Valid Preferences.

Step 4 – Signing your 'Web Preferences Receipt' with a student and parent/guardian digital signature.
